### HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE

The exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages, and claims arising out of exhibitor's activities on the event premises and will indemnify, defend and hold harmless Gluten Free Classes, LLC, the event, its owner, and its management company, as well as their respective agents, servants and employees from any and all such losses, damages and claims. This event caters to the allergen-free community and it will be your responsibility to know about your ingredients and your manufacturing practices. **YOU ARE REQUIRED TO BRING A LIST OF ALL INGREDIENTS FOR YOUR PRODUCTS AND HAVE THEM WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES.** You are also required to abide by the Health Department Rules and Regulations regarding food handling.
